

## Master of Teaching (Secondary) Course Map

(Information last updated on 16 September 2022)

### Students commencing from 2022 Semester 2 intake (24 months)

Students seeking to accelerate their studies by enrolling in more than two units during a Summer, Winter, Professional Term 2, or Professional Term 4 study period must first consult with their course co-ordinator.

For an even spread of workload, it is recommended that one unit of study be completed in each of the Winter and Summer study periods.

A program for students studying part-time (i.e. over a period longer than 24 months) would be: EDES591 and EDXX599 in the first semester; EDES590 in summer; EDXX699 and EDES600 in the first half of second year. They should plan out their study program in detail, consulting with their course co-ordinator, and also referring to the 18-month map for the full availability of units.

**Curriculum Pedagogy and Assessment (CPA):** Not all CPA units are offered in both semesters. Students should plan their enrolment based on availability from year to year. *Students for whom a second CPA1 study is not available in Semester 1 should study EDES600; then EDES690 in Winter; and the second CPA1 in Semester 2, in place of EDES690.*

Additional information about Literacy and Numeracy Test (LANTITE) will be provided upon enrolment.

**Alternative unit offerings:** Some units may also be offered in additional semesters from year to year.

**Elective offerings** are available in Professional Term 2, Semester 1, Semester 2 and Summer. *Semester 1 scheduled electives may overlap with placement days.* Students are recommended to do no more than 2 units during Professional Term or Summer.
