## **Study Load**

Domestic Students with outstanding prerequisites are advised to enrol in a maximum of three units in their first semester of study. This will help students have a smooth transition to university life and will also ensure the best chance to receive pass grades in all of their units.

For Centrelink purposes, studying three units is still considered full-time study.

International Students must study four units each semester due to VISA requirements.

## **Students with Outstanding Prerequisites (Enabling Units)**

Students in Queensland or Victoria who have not met prerequisite requirements in English, Mathematics, and/or Science must complete the relevant prerequisite units as part of the Diploma. ACU strongly encourages you to make an appointment to speak with your Course Advisor, to clarify any outstanding requirements.

Passing these Enabling Units will ensure that students meet the entry requirements into Initial Teacher Education (ITE) courses in Victoria and Queensland.

Please note that Enabling Units studied in the Diploma cannot be used for credit in the relevant ITE course.
