#### **UNIT DELIVERY MODES**

#### M - Multi-mode

#### **OU - Online unscheduled**

Learning activities are accessible anytime, anywhere. These units are normally delivered fully online and will **not** appear in a student's timetable.

#### OS - Online scheduled

All learning activities are held online, at scheduled times, and will require some attendance to enable online interaction. Activities will appear in a student's timetable.
