#### Four-week outlook: How you may be affected

Area	Impact	Timing
MGB - corner of Young Street and Little Victoria Street	Perimeter scaffold will continue to be erected around the north and west of the MGB (corner of Young Street and Little Victoria Street), to facilitate MGB overbuild works. This scaffold may reduce natural light inside the building. Please expect intermittent noise during this period.	December onward
Main construction site (corner of Victoria Parade and Napier Street)	Please expect intermittent construction noise while installation of the mega columns and trusses continues. Piling works are also ongoing.	December to February
MGB - levels 2 to 5	There will be restricted access to levels 2 to 5 of the MGB due to construction work. Signage has been installed around the MGB to assist with navigation and ensure staff and student safety.	December to February
Young Street	A mobile crane will be set up in front of the Daniel Mannix Building, resulting in changes to vehicle and pedestrian access in Young Street. This includes changes to how you access the ACU car park. Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to assist with traffic movements.	December to February

### Upcoming and ongoing activity

Area	Impact	Timing
Little Victoria Street	Little Victoria Street will continue to incur road and footpath closures to facilitate northern mega column and truss works. During this time, there will be changes to external access.	Ongoing
Main construction site (corner Victoria Parade and Napier St)	There will be ongoing construction noise. Pedestrians should be aware of increased construction vehicle movement around the construction site.	Ongoing

- preparation of the level 5 slab
- installation of window protection on the south side of the MGB
- opening of the new entrance to the MGB north cafe
- · demolition of the south external emergency escape stairs
- installation of mega columns on the north and west side of the MGB.
